Hands on Activities for KS2



Tudor House is a volunteer run museum. During WWII it was an Air Raid Warden's post and we have many artefacts and photographs dating from that time.

Outline of Activities

Our Volunteer staff lead activities, helped by teaching staff from the school

- Children find out how it felt to be an evacuee and they investigate the contents of evacuees suitcases
- With volunteers who were themselves children during the war, they explore the reasons for and consequences of rationing
- They experience the sounds of wartime, talk to our volunteer air raid wardens about their roles and handle the artefacts they would have used
- They meet someone who was an actual evacuee during WWII, hear about his adventures and have the chance to ask questions
